Importance of agricultural education in Thailand

- ✓ Employment in agriculture 30.9 % (FAO 2017), **lack of skilled professionals** in the agricultural sector.
- ✓ Agriculture is often seen as an **unattractive sector**, parents do not want their children working as farmers due to the perception that this implies hard work with insufficient profits.
- ✓ Enrolment rates in higher education (university) in Thailand is 2.4 % (UN Data, 2015).
- ✓ Among **main challenges** for students are low level of **English** (ICDE, 2015) and **absence of critical thinking skills** (Sivarnee 2013).

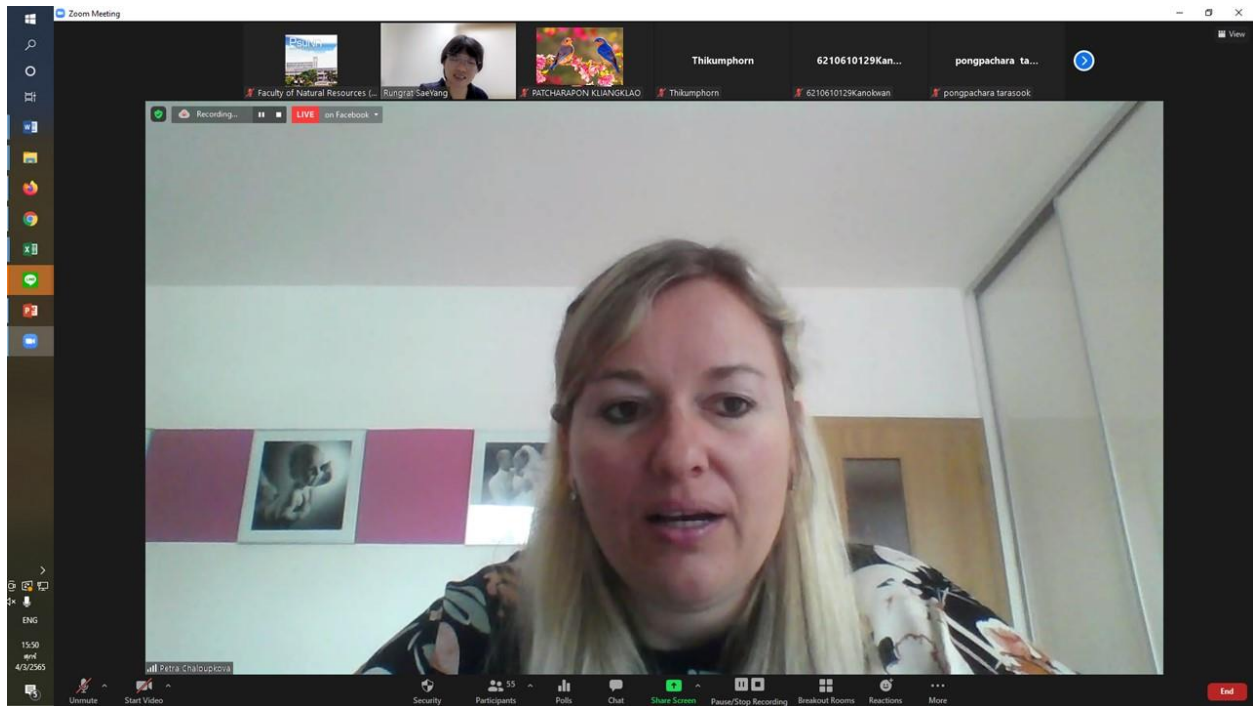

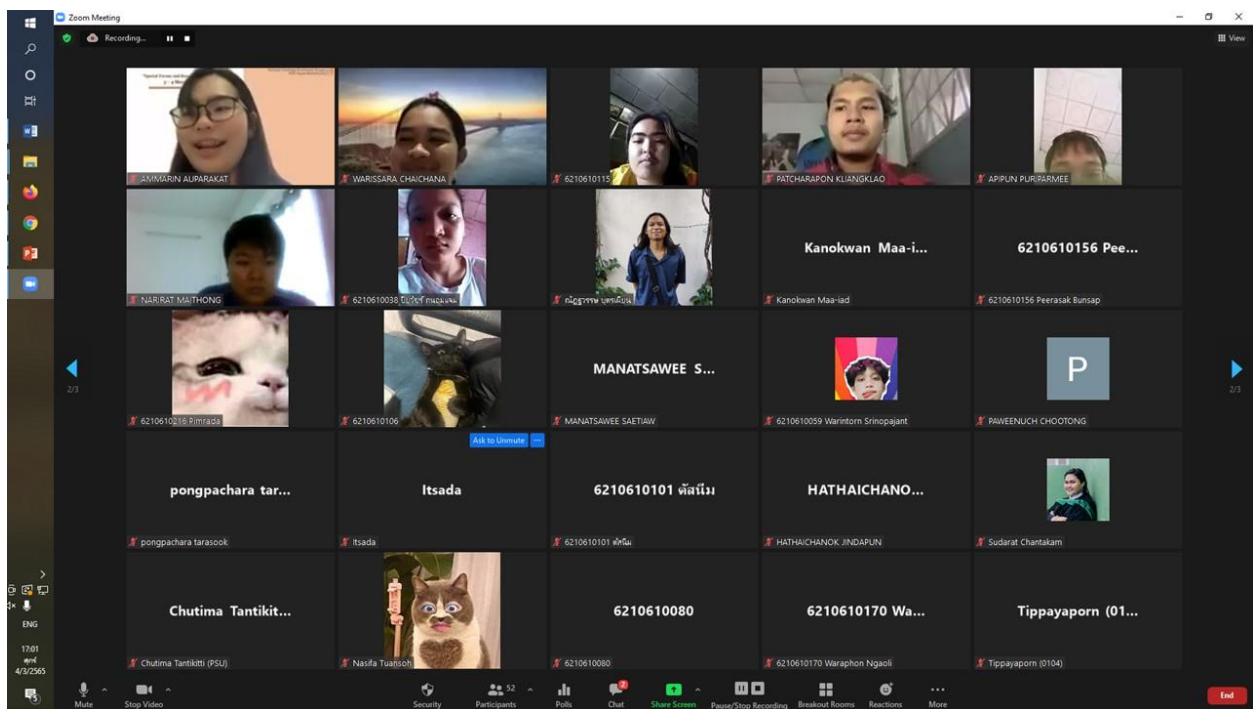
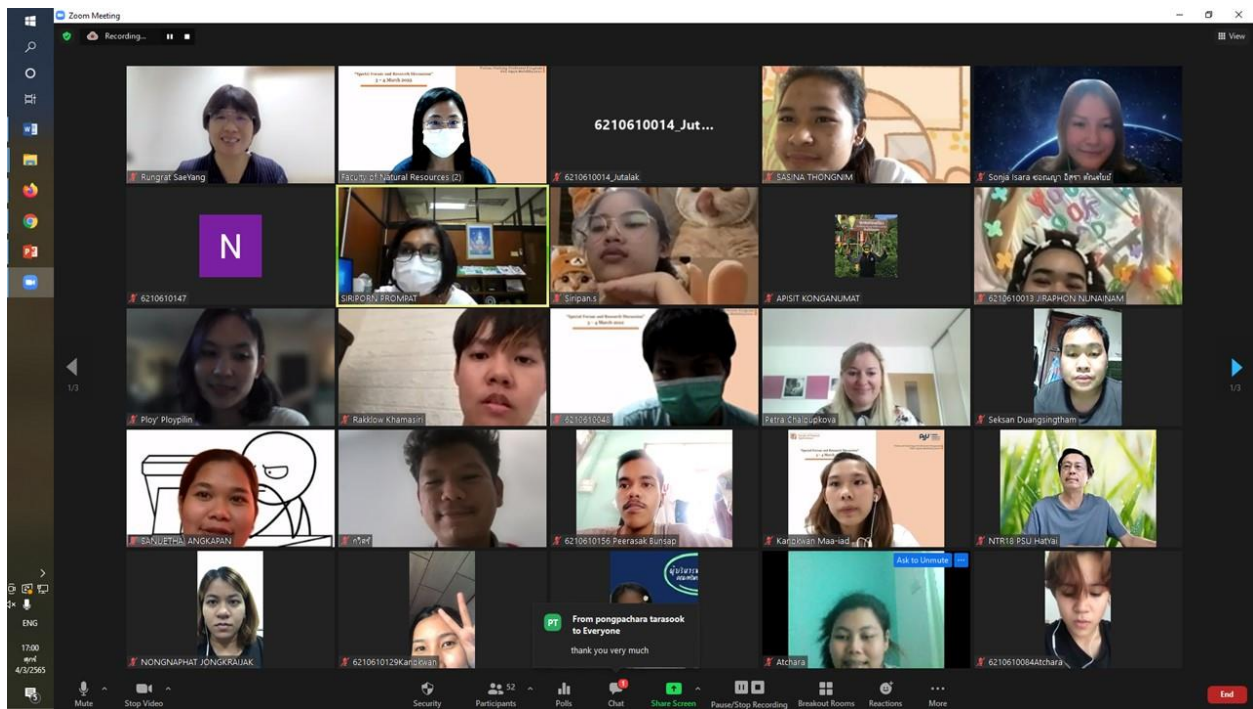
