Interviewer: Does anybody have an example of a time when they've had to advocate for Islam or being Muslim?

Student: I think that when we are faced with peers of ours that are not Muslim, I think they see us as, "Whoa you're doing all this stuff for your religion. I don't understand where you're coming from. Why are you doing it?" It's a long explanation. But it's also like I personally, "It's not my parents. It's not anyone that's trying to force me to do this stuff." I can say this for myself and probably everyone here. We personally understand our religion and want to be in it and follow it and believe in it because it gives us empowerment.

Interviewer: It's a choice, it's your choice.

Student: Yes. And that's something that I've had to explain to people many times.

Student: I think that personally I'm in a unique position when it comes to talking about people accepting you and having both an American and a Muslim identity because my mom is a convert and her whole family is not Muslim. Coming from her family, seeing my Islamic school is something so powerful to me because they visited the school on numerous occasions. My grandparents and my aunts and uncles are always in awe because they love what this school has done for us.

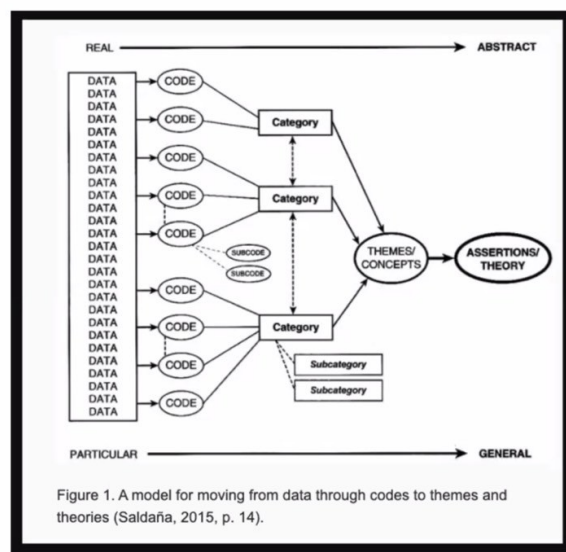
